Laxmi Dhital, 36 years old women is a residence of Dhulikhel Municipality, ward no. 11, Patlekhet, Dhitaltole. Her family's main source of income is agriculture and poultry farm.

She used to waste lots of her time in fetching water that comes from unmanaged source (shown in the picture). "We used to quarrel among neighbors for fetching water" she shared with us.

Now she can get enough water from her household tap because of which she can save her time which she used to spend on bringing water from a long distance. She said "she along with her son can use their

time in their business of poultry farm. In addition she has maintained cleanliness around her house.

She also added "household tap has brought feeling of brotherhood among the community people and with her neighbors as they used to have quarrel and disputes to fetch water from the traditional ponds and pipe.

Laxmi Dhital is one of the representatives of Dhitaltole WSS. One house one tap in a long run will improve quality of life of this community economically as well as socially.
